## International Money: Currency Conversion

Camilla Owl needs to change her money to the currency of the country that she is visiting.This is called FOREIGN EXCHANGE.
You can get this from most banks, post offices and currency shops. Look for a sign called 'Bureau de change'.

## Here's the maths:

To work out how much foreign currency Camilla gets:
Bermuda currency $\times$ Exchange rate $=$ Foreign currency
To work out how much money Camilla gets back:
Foreign currency $\div$ Exchange rate $=$ Bermuda dollars


## Exchange Rates Table

Can you do the math to work out how much different currencies Camilla can buy?

| Country | Symbol | Exchange rates <br> for BMD |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Australia | AU\$ | 1.83 AUD |
| European <br> countries | $€$ | 1.11 EUR |
| USA | US\$ | 1.25 USD (BMD) |
| India | ₹ | 95.03 INR |

Tips:
Use a calculator to work out the answer, but write down the working out part on a piece of paper.

The Bermuda (BMD) dollar is the same currency as the USA dollar.
